## AGENDA ITEM

### CWMS SCADA Systems

Michael Stephenson presented an in depth analysis of the SCADA system developed by the South East Group. The need for improved capability and quality pump station controllers was a necessity in the South East in 2011 and by 2013 upgrades to schemes in Tatiara and Beachport were rolled out. Mike explained the systems are fitted with Touchscreen controllers, ultrasonic level controls with pressure, temperature and flow monitors all accessible via a Telstra Router, and anywhere an internet interface can be achieved.



### Roadside Verges – Council responsibly or DPTi?

Victor Di Maria of the LGA Mutual Liability Scheme gave a detailed presentation on the responsibility of Road corridors along the states DPTi roads. Outlining the LG Act and the Highways Act in regards to this matter, interpretations vary from Councils perspective to DPTi's perspective, and the litigation involved in sorting "grey" areas, is what is trying to be resolved. Draft codes of practise were developed, with representation of LGA DPTi Councils and various stakeholder utilities. The codes of practise is currently on the table to be codified however inconsistencies exist within the lack of clarification of powers and the question of implications of current practices.



Victor has been invited back to give an update in the near future.

## GENERAL BUSINESS

- Suggestion to have dates set for meetings in 2015 at Secretary's discretion, keeping 4 meetings in the year, and keeping in mind not to clash with dates of other SALGSOA organisations (IE Southern and Hills being the 1<sup>st</sup> Friday quarterly starting February).
