*NOTES FROM THE MEETING HELD ON 8 SEPTEMBER 2010,
AT THE HACKNEY HOTEL*

1	Welcome	Meeting commenced at approximately 5.10pm. A list of those present and the apologies for the meeting can be found overleaf.
2	Minutes from last meeting	There were no formal minutes to accept from the last meeting.
3	Treasurer's reports	Although David Gear was an apology, Mal Chadwick indicated that the Associations current financial status is approximately \$15k in the bank; this includes the \$2.5k surplus from the recent Study Tour to Bendigo.
4	Memberships	There were 4 new applications received for membership. 2 municipal and 2 associate applications as follows: Darrin Smith - City of Mitcham, John Dorrestyn - Adelaide City Council, Ben Todd – Safe Concepts Dean Van Kempen – Prime Traffic Solutions. Vote taken, all found in favor of accepting all applicants. Neill Phillips to write to all applicants to welcome them to the Association.

5	New Business	<p>Discussion was held in relation to writing formally to the President of IPWEA (SA) regarding attendance to combined meetings of IPWEA (SA) and other industry organisations. An invitation is sent to SALGSOA (Metro) to boost numbers in which our Associations members are expected to pay costs. Mal will write to IPWEA (SA) to explain the Associations position in regards to paying fees to attend events. Vote taken, all in favor.</p>
	New Business (cont)	<p>Discussion on possibility of changes to Associate (Corporate) Memberships. In relation to the number of staff a company can bring to a meeting as an Associate Member and if this should be limited to 1 or 2. Typically a company can attend a meeting or two to see if they want to become a member. They can bring along 1 or 2 staff with them. If they then decide it appears worthwhile being a member they can apply for Associate Membership.</p> <p>It was decided that a review be undertaken and discussions at the next general meeting to establish a protocol for sponsorships of meetings as well as number of attendees from companies once a single Associate Membership has been paid for. Vote taken, all in favor.</p>
6	Study Tour	<p>It has been suggested that the Study Tour for 2011 could be in Echuca, Victoria. Echuca is set within an irrigated pastoral and agricultural district on the Murray River, directly north of Melbourne (approx, 208 km) and just across the river is the New South Wales border town of Moama. The coach/bus has been booked with a recommendation for the usual driver Kevin. Possible paddle steamer river cruise as well as tour of the Humes Rinker pre-cast production warehouse which is situated in Echuca. More details to come after the recognisance trip by Mal in February 2011.</p>
